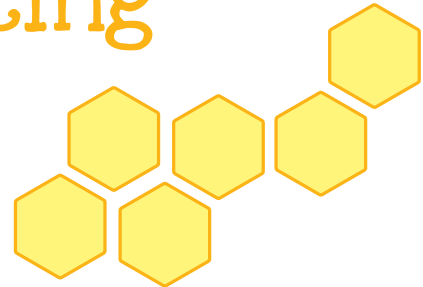
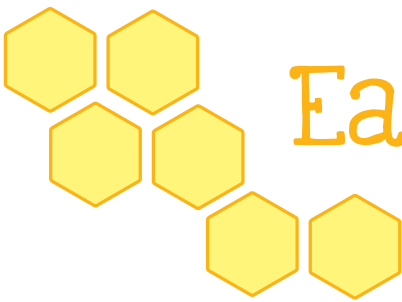

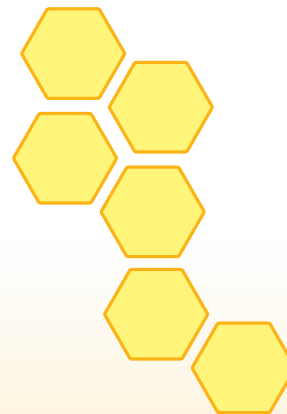
How ADULTS promote being Safe, Kind, & Responsible



How INFANTS & TODDLERS will demonstrate being Safe, Kind, & Responsible

- Stay calm
- Stay physically close
- Use descriptive language
- Provide primary caregiving
- Establish routines
- Holding hands
- Face to face contact
- Showing delight
- Responding to child's cues
- Use encouraging words and approaches

- Verbal reinforcement
- Modeling
- Giving bees
- Smile/wink/hug/high-five
- Clapping
- Cheering
- Special songs
- Intentional teaching of program-wide expectations
- Plan for transitions
- Provide active supervision



- Gently touching a friend
- Helping to put toys away
- Wiping up a spill
- Clearing the table after meals
- Asking about a friend in distress
- Noticing when a friend is absent
- Asking for physical contact when upset
- Using words to get friends to "stop"
